### Manitowoc County Shingle Recycling

The Manitowoc County Shingle Recycling Site will begin accepting shingles and vinyl siding on Monday September 9<sup>th</sup> at 7:00am. Incoming loads will be weighed and charged on a per ton basis according to the fees and guidelines listed below. Shingles processed at this site will be sorted, cleaned and recycled into asphalt for road projects.

#### Location and Hours

Manitowoc County Highway Department - Quarry  
3500 STH 310, Manitowoc WI  
Monday – Friday 7:00am to 3:30pm



#### Fees

- \$50.00 per ton – Dirty Loads of Shingles
- \$45.00 per ton – Sorted Loads of Shingles
- \$40.00 per ton – Clean Loads of Shingles
- \$30.00 per ton – Vinyl Siding

#### Guidelines

- Dirty loads contain material that comes off of a roof. Must contain at least 80% shingles by weight. Any loads with more garbage weight will be rejected.
- Sorted loads will have waste material from a roof loaded on top of a shingle load (waste must be 20% or less of the total load weight). Hauler or roofing contractor must dispose of waste in proper containers.
- Clean loads consist of only shingles, tar paper and nails. Shingle weight should be 99% of the load.
- Vinyl siding loads must only contain vinyl siding (100% of the load weight). Nothing else should be in the load. The hauler or roofing contractor is to place vinyl siding in the proper containers.
- Cedar shake shingles are not allowed on the site.
- Asbestos and other hazardous or special waste materials are not allowed on site. Commercial roofing projects may be required to provide asbestos test results.
- Collection employees reserve the right to reject loads and to judge whether a customer is charged based on a dirty, sorted or clean load.
- Payment is due immediately. Cash, local checks, and credit cards are accepted.
